...was an Asian-American who became the first Chinese-American woman to work for the federal government and the first Chinese-American woman to vote. Tye was born in California and had a heart for helping other Asian-Americans. She would take the civil service exam and pass, and worked as an interpreter on Angel Island—where many immigrants from Asia would Ο come through. In 1912, Tye made news as the first Chinese-American woman to vote in the United States. When she was interviewed about her voting experience, Tye said: "I wanted to KNOW what was right, not to act blindly..."
